12-15 CLASSROOM (MIDDLE SCHOOL)

School Supplies for students in the 12-15 Class:

The following items will be shared. There is no need to label with child's name.

- 4 magic rub erasers (pink please - no colors)
- 2 packages of #2 pencils
- 2 boxes (12 count) Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pack (10 count) blue or black pens
- 1 pack of red ink pens
- 4 highlighters (**NOT** yellow)
- 4 black Sharpies (permanent markers)
- 1 pack of assorted colored Sharpies (permanent marker)
- 1 box (8 count) of THIN Crayola markers
- 1 box (8 count) of THICK Crayola markers
- 1 box (24 count) of Crayola crayons
- 1 zippered pencil pouch / or pencil box w/lid
- 4 packages (200 count) of **wide** ruled notebook paper
- 2 packages of graphing paper
- 4 packages (100 count) of 3x5 index cards
- 1 pair of scissors (age appropriate; what will best fit your child's hand)
- 2 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 box of 30 glue sticks
- 5 white poster boards, pack of 5 (or five individual poster boards) 22" by 28"
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 boxes of sandwich zip-lock bags
- Expo Markers (any amount, any color)
- Rubber Bands

If you would like, you may label following items with child's first name.

- 4 package of notebook dividers (5 tabs)
- 4 solid color 1" 3 ring binders
- 1 solid color 1" 3 ring binders **with plastic pocket on front**
- 2 folders (any color/design)

Please bring all items in a large bag or box labeled with your child's name so that their items can be checked off. Thank you. ☺
