LIFE SKILLS CLASSROOM

School Supplies for students in the Life Skills Class:

The following items will be shared. There is no need to label with child's name.

- 4 magic rub erasers (pink please - no colors)
- 2 boxes (24 count) #2 pencils
- 1 pack blue or black pens
- 4 highlighters (**NOT** yellow)
- 2 box (black & any colors) **Sharpie** permanent markers
- 2 boxes of **Crayola** colored pencils
- 1 box (8 count) of **THIN Crayola** markers
- 1 box (8 count) of **THICK / BROAD Crayola** markers
- 2 boxes (24 count) of **Crayola** crayons
- 3 packages of notebook dividers (5 tabs)
- 2 bottles of **Elmer's** glue
- 1 box of 30 **Elmer's** glue sticks
- 2 pairs of scissors (appropriate for your child's age)
- 2 stamp pads (any dark colors – blue, purple, black, green)
- 1 pack of (100) index cards
- 1 pack of **3M Post-It** Notes
- 1 box (black & any colors) **Expo** dry erase makers
- 1 bag of assorted rubber bands
- 1 box of large (gallon) zip-lock bags
- 1 bottle Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues

If you would like, you may label following items with child's first name.

- 1 **plastic** green folder with 2 pockets & 3 prongs
- 1 **plastic** red folder with 2 pockets & 3 prongs
- 2 **plastic** folder with 2 pockets (any color)
- 2 solid color 1" 3 ring binders
- 1 solid color 1" 3 ring binders **with plastic pocket on front**
- 1 solid color 2" 3 ring binders **with plastic pocket on front**
- 6 **wide** rule composition books (any color)

Please bring all items in a large bag or box labeled with your child's name so that their items can be checked off. Thank you. ☺

***Please note:** Any additional supply donations should be brought directly to the school office. We can always use items such as copy paper, construction paper, laminate, plastic utensils (forks & spoons), Clorox wipes, and tissues. Thank you.*
